What did the author explain well?	I think the author was able to explain the reasoning behind why they thought that methane from cattle contribute to greenhouse gas emissions.
What evidence was included that meaningfully supported the author's argument?	The author did not include any evidence in their response.
What questions do you have that can help the author improve on their reasoning or evidence?	I also think what you said about cattle being the biggest cause of climate change was incorrect. I'm wondering what evidence you have to support these claims?
What claims were inaccurate? What would you say to challenge this claim?	Some reasoning that you shared that I think could be improved on is that cow burps are causing climate change because they emit methane into the atmosphere.

What additional information should the author pursue to improve their argument?	I think we could compare the amounts of methane released by cattle to the emissions from other industries to figure out the scale of the impact of cattle relative to other greenhouse gas sources. These two actions would help us make progress on our disagreement.
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
